

KBGH POOL RULES

1. Members and guests must register at the desk upon entering the Club (State Regulation).
2. **NO DIVING** INTO THE MAIN POOL on the shallow side of the rope. DIVING WILL BE ALLOWED OFF THE BLOCKS DURING SUPERVISED SWIM TEAM EVENTS/PRACTICES. THIS IS THE ONLY EXCEPTION.
3. No one will be permitted in the pool unless the Lifeguards are on duty and on the deck.
4. Running, pushing, wrestling, or other activities causing undue disturbance are prohibited in the Club.
5. No glass containers of any kind are allowed at KBGH.
6. Writing on pool property (graffiti) or defacing any pool property will not be tolerated. Violators will face disciplinary action including possible eviction from the club.
7. IT IS EVERY MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP THE CLUB CLEAN, not just the staff's duty. All trash, refuse and recyclables shall be placed in containers provided by the Club. Gum chewing is discouraged within the pool grounds.
8. Swimmers must wear proper swimming attire in the pool, no street clothing.
9. Spitting, or spouting of water and similar unhygienic action is prohibited.
10. The following special rules must be observed in the DIVING WELL:
 - a) Non-swimmers (no band) and Novice swimmers (Red Band) will be allowed in the diving well ONLY WITH DIRECT SUPERVISION of an adult or Approved Baby-sitter, AND with the approval of the Lifeguard
 - b) Swimming in the diving well is only allowed with the approval of the Lifeguard and only when no one is using the diving boards.
 - c) Only one person is allowed on the diving boards at a time including the diving board step.
 - d) Do not hang from the edge of the diving board or dive/jump to the side of the diving board. You must jump straight forward, not towards the other diving board jump zone.
 - e) No excessive springing on the diving board.
 - f) The white diving board is only rated for 250 lbs. No one over 250 lbs. shall use this board.
 - g) A diver must wait until the previous person has cleared the water in front of the board.
10. Only one person is allowed on the tube slide at a time including the stairway. Wait until the previous person clears the area in front of the slide.
11. All persons using the Club facilities do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. The Club, directors of said club and/or Management does not assume responsibility for any accident, injury, loss or damage to personal property or any other loss incurred in connection with such use.
12. The entire facilities of the Club are under direct supervision of the Directors, Manager and Lifeguards. They have the authority/duty to evict anyone from the pool for the day after fair warning of misconduct. Repeated offenses may subject the offender to suspension of Club privileges as determined by the Board of Directors.
13. Members shall direct all problems including injuries to the Pool Manager or to Lifeguards on duty.
14. Head Lifeguard or Manager reserves the right to close the Club without Notice due to inclement weather, health or safety concerns.

15. For parties held during regular business hours, members will be required to pay for all guests. There is no rental fee; however, the pool manager must be notified in advance. We want to avoid two parties at the same time. Members must be responsible for cleaning up their party area.

Special Rules applying to Children

1. AN ADULT or an Approved Baby-sitter MUST ACCOMPANY CHILDREN UNDER AGE 10. Children between the ages of 10 and 12 may enter the Club alone after proving their ability to obtain a **black** band. Parents always assume responsibility for the child's behavior at the pool. IF CHILDREN OVER THE AGE OF 10 BECOME BEHAVIORAL PROBLEMS, THE POOL MANAGER MAY SUSPEND THEIR ABILITY TO ENTER WITHOUT SUPERVISION.
2. The Lifeguards will exercise general supervision over the wading pool, but they are not responsible for anyone in the wading pool area. Only children 6 years and under will be permitted in the wading pool.
3. Everyone (including guests) under the age of 13 must comply with the Club's Color Band policy.
4. Children under the age of 7 may wear lifejackets, water wings or other flotation aids if under close supervision by an adult or approved baby-sitter. All other flotation aids such as inner tubes, rafts and air mattresses will not be permitted except by permission of the Lifeguards or Manager.
5. At the discretion of the Lifeguard, an "Adult Swim" may be called wherein ALL children must clear the pool.
6. Children, who are not toilet trained, must wear leak-proof swim diapers or other leak-proof undergarments. The FECAL policy posted on the bulletin board must be followed.
7. All bicycles shall be parked in designated areas. No scooters, in-line skate, skateboards shall be used in the pool area and breezeway.
8. The lifeguards are present for the protection of members and not serve as babysitters. Excessive loitering at their stations including the office area is prohibited. No game playing in the office area.

Guest Policy

1. The intent of the guest policy is to allow members to invite guests on an occasional basis and prevent non-members from circumventing the normal membership procedures.
2. Members shall accompany their guests at all times and shall be responsible for all their actions.
3. The Club reserves the right to restrict the number of guests permitted to enter the club and to change the guest policy.
4. Any person living within a fifteen mile radius of the club may only enter as a guest a total of five times during any one season.
5. All guests must register at the office.
6. **Guest Fees (Children 4 and under free)**
 - a) Day guest \$5.00/day
 - b) Twilight guest (after 4:30) \$2.50/day
 - c) Book of ten day passes \$40.00

KBGH POOL RULES

The Club has established a Color Band System to enable instant identification of swimming qualifications of children under 13 years of age. It has been proven to be an effective measure to help ensure the safety of our children while they are at the Club. The Club supplies colored bands at no charge according to the following rules:

- 1) **NON-SWIMMER (No Band)** - Any child who has not qualified for a red or black band must be accompanied by an adult or Approved Baby-sitter. While the child is in the pool, the adult or Approved Baby-sitter must be physically present on the immediate deck area or in the water to supervise this child.
- 2) **NOVICE (Red Band)** - Any child who can swim one lap of the pool (25 yards) and tread water for one minute will be allowed to use the pool without being accompanied by an adult. However, he/she will only be permitted to use the shallow area of the main pool except when under the direct supervision of a parent, adult or Approved Baby-sitter.
- 3) **SWIMMER (Black Band)** - Any child who can swim 2 laps of the pool (50 yards), tread water for two minutes and jump or dive from the diving board will be permitted to use any area of the pool without being accompanied by an adult.
- 4) **APPROVED BABYSITTERS** - To qualify as an Approved Baby-sitter, a person must be at least 14 years old, must be qualified to assist the child in a water emergency and must take responsibility for the child. If the Manager or Lifeguards determine that the baby-sitter is not providing adequate supervision, this privilege can be revoked for cause at any time.

It is the responsibility of the adult or Approved Baby-sitter to supervise any Non-Swimmer or Novice when that child is in restricted areas. **REMEMBER that LIFEGUARDS ARE HERE FOR THE SAFETY OF PATRONS - NOT TO SERVE AS BABYSITTERS.**

The Pool Manager, or appointed Lifeguard, will have the final decision as to the qualifications and classification of any child. The Pool Manager or Lifeguard can require any person to take a rest period if they judge it to be necessary. Anyone above the age of 12 may also be restricted from certain areas of the pool by the Manager or his/her representative if he/she feels the swimmer lacks the ability to continue safely. Any Lifeguard or the Pool Manager will administer the swimming test. **THE TEST MUST BE TAKEN EVERY YEAR.**
